

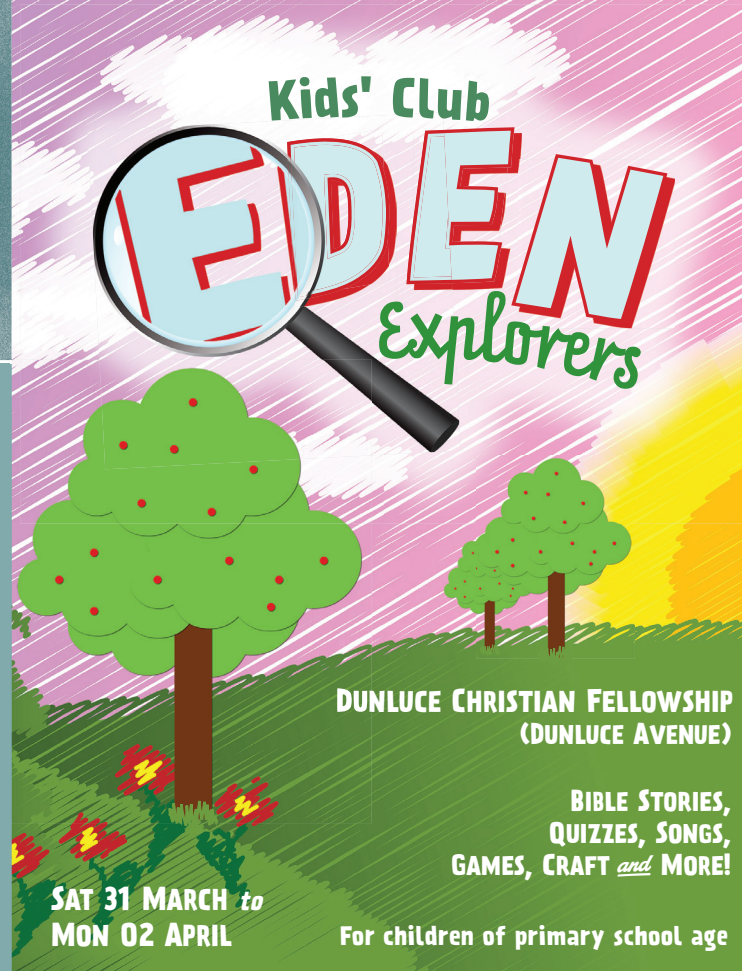
## CEF® EASTER CONFERENCE
