**Good News Club Camp** took place in Seaview House in July. *Gary Chambers* was one of the leaders

"We knew there would be some challenges as children got back into the swing of things after not having been at camp before - we had a whole camp of children who were all at camp for the first time!

Our teaching was on John the Baptist, a faithful messenger of God preparing the way for Jesus. We all heard the gospel message that he taught in Bible times, retold through Olivia and Karen.

Of course, camp had great activities, such as fancy dress, our classic trip to Coco's, and the spectacular water fight!

Most important of all, we saw God at work, with many of the campers standing up in front of everyone to share their testimonies and even more did so in small groups in dorm time on the last night. There were many of the children at camp who knew the Lord and we trust the camp helped

strengthen them in their faith. One boy said, "This week has really helped me to understand things about Jesus for the first time". We pray that God will continue to challenge those who have not yet trusted Him but heard the gospel message on our week of camp".
