We are thankful to God for two ladies from Italy who completed the Children's Ministry Leadership Course (CMLC) in Ireland last Autumn. They have been accepted into the work in Italy. Sarah lives on the island of Sciliy and plans to establish a CEF ministry there and Ioana lives in Genoa. They are conducting ministry in their areas but they also have to raise financial and prayerful support. Andrew spent ten days in Italy at the end of March visiting churches, home groups and past TCE students sharing the vision of Every Child, Every Nation, Every Day.

We thank God for Giorgio who travelled with Andrew to each meeting and interpreted for him. Andrew also had the opportunity to teach a lesson at a Roma Good News Club® (GNC®). The last three days were spent at the Camp Centre outside Milan with the workers, Board members and Stephen Garrett also attended to conduct the Bible teaching. It was a wonderful opportunity to spend time around God's Word and worship God together through praise and prayer.

Please pray that God will bring along new Board members as some of the current Board will stand down at the end of this term. We are thankful for the time and dedication of the current Board to the ministry and ask you to pray that God will work in the heart of someone or some couple to take on the role of National Director in Italy.

Ministry in Spain



We thank God for the small team in Spain who are faithfully training volunteers and building ministries. They had never attended an Instructor of Teachers Course (IOT 1 & 2) due to financial and time constraints. We praise God that through the generosity of His people they were able to send five students to the IOT 1 training course in Sibiu, Romania last Autumn. In March one of the workers attended the Junior Youth Challenge Instructors Course (JYCIC). This was a hybrid course with the first week held on Zoom and the second week in person in Sibiu, Romania.

This Autumn one worker will attend IOT 1 training and five students will attend the IOT 2 training, this is a great encouragement and help for the team in Spain. Please pray as they conduct Teaching Children Effectively™ (TCE™) Courses that many students will attend the course and as a result they will commence GNCs in their area. We thank God for Helen who completed CMLC in Portugal last year and has been accepted as a new worker with the team in Spain. Please pray for Helen as she seeks to raise her support and also establish ministry in the Tarragona area. We are thankful for the GNCs and Youth groups that have already commenced in her home and also in the nearby town of Reus.
