It is also a new chapter in the life of our son Joel, who will be starting Ballyclare Secondary in September. Mossley Primary school has served us well and we would value prayer for this transition. Often, while we are speaking to the children in the area, we encourage them to trust in God. This is a timely reminder that as CEF workers; 'we have to practice, what we preach!'

"Many of you reading our prayer letter will know that a few years ago we had a bank slippage at Seaview, our camp centre in Kilkeel. We can report that the subsidence was cleared back in the autumn and the contractor commenced work in the middle of May to repair the issue. The cost of the overall project will be approximately £320,000. We are so thankful to God that over £150,000 has already been given towards the project.

Please pray that the remaining finances will come in to enable us to pay the contractor and the other bills associated with this project. Pray too for safety for the contractor and his workmen and that there will be no further delays. The contractor is hoping to have the issue sorted by the end of June."

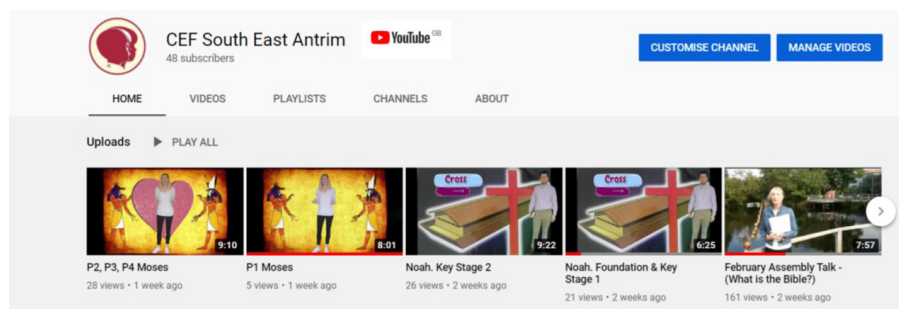
